Failure to Appear

Your next hearing is scheduled for July 17th, 2014, at 8 a.m. If you fail to appear for this hearing and there are no exceptional circumstances beyond your control which caused your absence, a hearing may be held in your absence and an order of removal may be entered against you. Furthermore, you may become ineligible for 10 years after the date of the order of removal for voluntary departure under

INA - 240B, cancellation of removal under INA - 240A, and for adjustment of status and change of status under INA -- 245, 248, and 249. Exceptional circumstances which may excuse your absence are those such as:

- 1. You have a serious illness.
- 2. Your spouse, child, or parent has a serious illness or has died.
- 3. You, your child or parent has suffered battery or extreme cruelty, *but not* circumstances less compelling.
